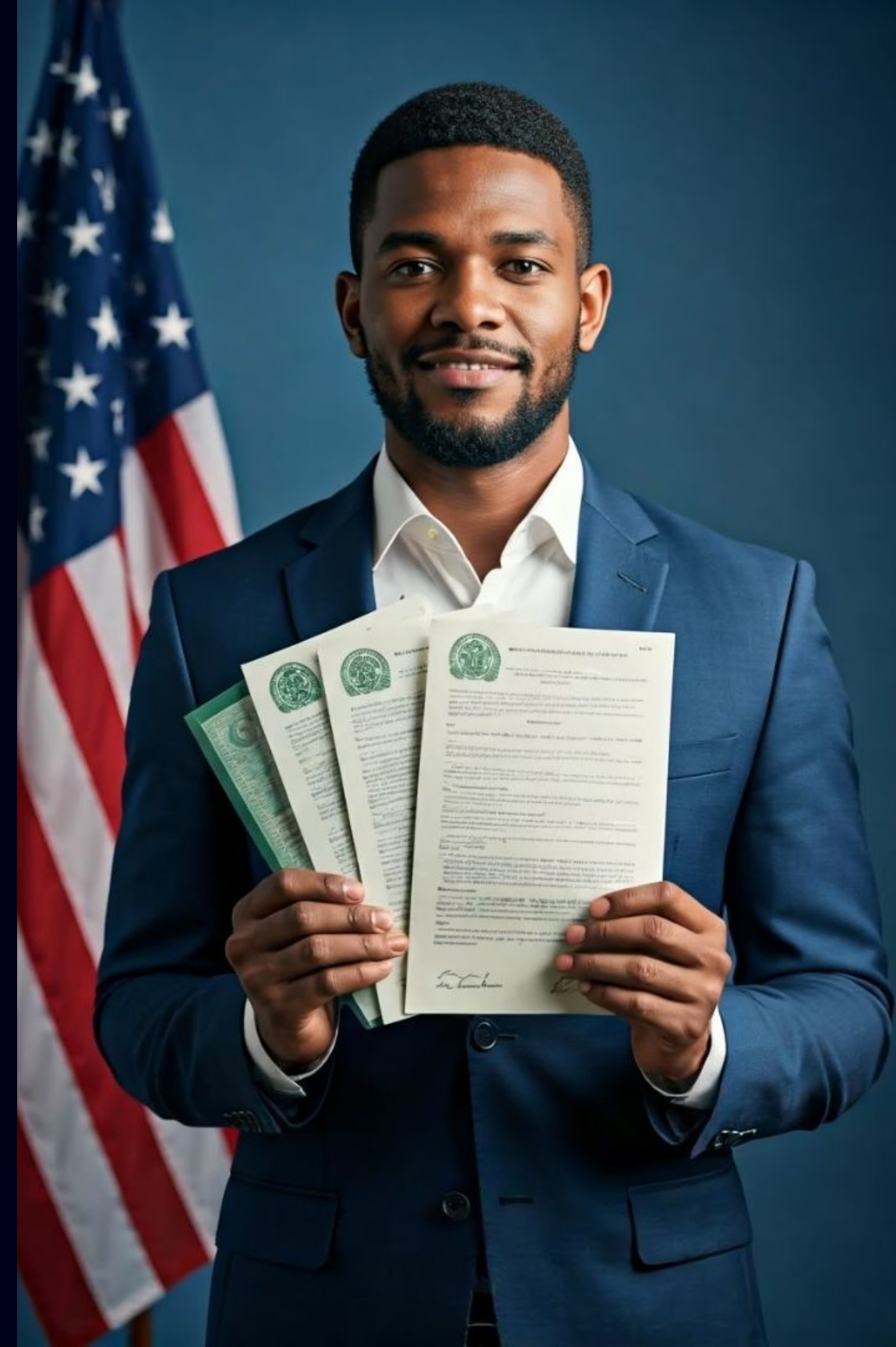

# Understanding EB-1 and EB-2 NIW Pathways

The EB-1 and EB-2 NIW categories offer distinct paths to permanent residency for exceptional individuals. Understanding these pathways is essential for determining which category best suits your qualifications.

The National Interest Waiver (NIW) is particularly significant as it allows applicants to self-petition without employer sponsorship if their work substantially benefits the United States.

## EB-1 Category

Requires evidence of sustained national or international acclaim and recognition in your field.

## EB-2 Category

For professionals with advanced degrees or exceptional ability in sciences, arts, or business.

The NIW component waives the labor certification requirement if the applicant's work is in the national interest.

- At least 2 of 6 specific criteria

## EB-2 NIW Requirements

- Advanced degree or exceptional ability
- Work of substantial merit
- National importance
- Well-positioned to advance endeavor
